


CCBC High Performance Coaching Seminar





Ski Preparation Course NCCP Level 4 - Task #3

This Task covers shop set up, what goes in the tool box, maintenance of tools, ski selection, wax application, testing procedures (grip & glide), hand tuning, and stone grinding.

Prerequisites:

q <u>Division recommendation</u>.

• Only applicants recommended by their Division will be accepted.

- q <u>Resume.</u>
 - Experience as a wax technician at club and regional level races (explain how frequently/year, and for how many years)
 - Experience as a wax technician at provincial cup level races (explain how frequently/year, and for how many years)
 - Experience as a wax technician at a National Championships, Nor Ams, Canada Cup, Western/Eastern Canadian Championships, Canada Winter Games. Provide details.

This course is limited to 14 participants.
