**Wax Rooms** – Team waxing rooms may be requested, and will be assigned based on registered numbers of competitors; smaller teams may have to share wax rooms. There is a \$ 40 deposit on all team room keys, which can be obtained at the Race Office starting 10:00 am on Dec 19th.

#### **Trail Passes:**

During the 3 days from Dec. 19<sup>th</sup> to Dec. 21st, all athletes and coaches on skis MUST have a trail pass or have a bib on. Passes are available at the race office at a competitor rate of \$4/day. Registered coaches will be provided a complimentary pass for each day. Coaches must register at the Race Office. The penalty for skiing without pass is \$172.00, enforced by Parks staff.

## **Race Licences:**

All competitors from Juvenile category and up must have a CCC or FIS license. A CCC supporting member license (day license) may be purchased at the time of registration for a fee of \$5.00/day.

Competitors Midget category and younger must be a member of a CCC registered club, but do not require a license. Non CCC club members may register after purchasing a CCC supporting member license.





#### Waivers:

All racers must sign a waiver. For racers over 18 years of age, this waiver will be signed as part of the on-line registration via Zone4. Those under 18 must have a hard copy of the waiver signed by a parent or guardian. All waivers must be received by the Competition Secretary by 8:00 pm, Dec.19<sup>th</sup>, 2008 or registration is forfeited. Waiver forms are available online, attached to the race notice, or at the race office.

## **Entry Process and Deadline:**

# 2. All Entries must be received by 8 ;00 pm MST, Wednesday, December 17th, 2008.

The first step in achieving correct official results in a timely fashion is the receipt (by the race secretary) of complete, correct, on-time entries. Late entries cause problems, and are therefore **strongly discouraged**. Late entries will be accepted **only in the race office** on Dec. 19th, 2008 until 3 p.m. with full payment **INCLUDING THE LATE ENTRY PENALTY OF \$100.00**, and will forfeit the right to seeding. **There is no race day registration**.

## Course distances may vary according to weather and trail conditions. A note about 'age categories':

Each skier has a 'competition age', which remains the same for the entire competition season. All competitive ski seasons span 2 calendar years (ie 2008, 2009). For purposes of 'competition age', the latter year is used. So, for this upcoming season, 2009 is used for all skiers. This means that a skier's 'competition age' for this entire season is the age attained on his/her birthday in the year 2009.

**Seeding**: Seeding will be performed in accordance with the Alberta Cup Technical Package. Verification lists will be prepared prior to the coaches meetings in consultation with the Technical Delegate. These will be reviewed by the coaches / team captains during the first 15 minutes of Friday's team captains' meeting. **This will be the last chance for corrections or changes,** after which the start lists will be prepared. Therefore, it is **highly recommended** for all racers that they be represented by a coach / manager at this meeting.

#### D. PARANORDIC SKIERS:

Paranordic skiers are invited to compete in all Alberta Cups. Final decisions about race distances and categories will be made on Friday, December 19<sup>th</sup>, dependent upon Paranordic registrations received by that time.

#### E. EVENT WAIVER AND RELEASE:

- 1. Athletes under 18 years of age must have a hard copy waiver signed by their parent or guardian and submitted manually.
- 2. On line waivers will only be accepted for racers 18 years of age and older.
